Environmental Education Programs are offered Tuesday - Friday. We are happy to work with you to tailor programs to meet your content needs.

Feathered Friends

Discover a habitat chock full of birds by learning basic birding techniques, what beaks and feet tell us about our feathered friends, and completing other bird-based activities.

Recommended for grades K- 5.

Survival Skills

Learn how to survive in the wild by gaining skills in water filtration, fire and shelter construction, and how to properly equip yourself for the wild. Recommended for 6th grade & below, depending on the teacher's discretion.



What's in the Water?

Learn about freshwater ecology by studying macroinvertebrates in our stormwater retention pond. Discover the importance of water quality in our communities by collecting data on turbidity, pH, dissolved oxygen levels, and more.

Recommended for grades 5-12.

Wetland Critter Study

Inspect our range of wetland animal skulls to learn more about who we share this environment with, search for signs of their presence, and figure out how they are all connected.

Recommended for grades 2-6.

Marsh Madness

Learn about the importance of wetlands through hands-on activities, wetland walks, and more. This class illustrates how wetlands work in the water cycle and can include activities with a focus on wetland flora & fauna.

Recommended for grades K-5.

"Neature" Walk

This program will help you understand how NEAT nature really is! Along our walk, we will engage in activities that encourage participants to connect with and appreciate their environment in new ways. Recommended for grades K-4.



Summer Camps

Bring your campers to Sankofa Wetland Park where they can explore and discover the wetlands right in their own backyard! Lots of hands-on fun outside! Programs can accommodate up to 25 campers at a time. \$5 per camper.
